



Best Western Le Strange Arms Hotel

Old Hunstanton, Norfolk

The hotel, located in the village of Old Hunstanton, overlooks the sea. Although standing on the east coast of England it faces west across the Wash, famous for its sunsets and wildlife. The hotel grounds sweep down to one of the finest, sandy beaches in an area of many lovely beaches.

The coast is an “area of outstanding natural beauty”, largely undeveloped, with charming flint and pantiled villages in quiet countryside. Close by are the RSPB reserves of Titchwell and Snettisham with whom the hotel has a close relationship. Also in the vicinity are the great houses and estates of Sandringham, Holkham and Houghton. Norfolk Lavender is only minutes away. To test the golfer, Hunstanton is half a mile from the hotel, with Royal Norfolk, Cromer and Swaffham within easy reach.

The traditional seaside town of Hunstanton is close by, with its famous “striped” cliffs, promenade and many other attractions including the Sea Life Centre. Opposite the hotel are the Old Barns, one of the largest antiques, arts and crafts centres in Norfolk.

Best Western Le Strange Arms Hotel has 36 individually decorated bedrooms and suites with the facilities you expect from a well appointed hotel. The hotel has a comfortable lounge, lounge bar and a stylish restaurant offering table d’hôte and speciality menus featuring fresh and local produce.



Next to the hotel is the Ancient Mariner Inn, a popular village pub which welcomes families and is renowned for its choice of real ales and wines. It has its own Galley Restaurant for more informal dining and bar meals.



Adjacent to the Ancient Mariner is The Boat House with panoramic views down to the sea. It has two self catering apartments on two floors and on the lower ground floor two individual guest bedrooms.
