ATTRACTIONS AND STATELY HOMES

Peterborough Cathedral - 2½ miles. Glorious early 12th cent. Norman Cathedral, uncluttered with an air of space and purity.

Peterborough Museum - 2 miles. Jurassic sea monsters, Roman artifacts, memorabilia of Napoleonic prisoners of war.

Flag Fen - One of the most important prehistoric sites in Europe.

Reconstructed roundhouses from the Iron and Bronze ages - new Millennium Centre with a park of rare and ancient breeds of animal.

Nene Valley Railway - The home of Thomas the Tank Engine.

7½ miles of track between Yarwell and Peterborough through Ferry meadows.

Burghley House - at Stamford - 8 miles. home of the world famous Burghley Horse Trials in September. Fabulous Elizabethan House, home of the Cecil family for 400 years.

Queensgate Shopping Centre - 2½ miles in the heart of the city.

Peterborough Dog Stadium - 5 miles. Racing 4 nights a week, a la carte restaurant and up to date facilities.
